Dear Lindbergh Parents and Guardians,

Welcome to the 2022-2023 school year! We hope you and your family have enjoyed a wonderful summer and are as excited as we are to welcome our new and returning students to Lindbergh!

There are probably a lot of questions about this school year and what to expect. We will try our best to continue to share valuable information as they become available. Our main focus will continue to be the safety and security of our students, staff, families and community. Below I have included some information to get us started.

A little bit about Lindbergh for our new parents, Lindbergh is a Leader in Me Lighthouse school. Our continued commitment to the Leader in Me ensures we are teaching 21st-century leadership and life skills to students and creating a culture of student empowerment based on the idea that every child can be a leader. Additionally, in 2019, Lindbergh Elementary was recognized by the U.S. Department of Education as a National Blue Ribbon School in the Exemplary High Performance School category. This is the highest recognition that can be bestowed on a school. Our school hours are from 9:00AM-3:55PM. Our ENTRY bell will ring at 8:55AM. The TARDY bell will ring at 9:00AM. Dismissal for all half days is 12:05PM.

- The first day of school, **Monday, August 29th, is a half day of school** with dismissal at 12:05.
- Tuesday, August 30th will be a full day of school for students in grades 1st-5th.

**Late Starts:** On late start days, school will begin **1 hour later** with the entry bell ringing at **9:55AM** and the tardy bell at **10:00AM**

# **Young 5's/Kindergarten Soft Start:**

Young 5's and Kindergarteners will have a soft start, meaning half days of school for the first 2 weeks of school from **Aug. 29th to Sept. 9th with a dismissal time at 12:05PM**. Soft start allows for a gradual transition to school. During the two weeks of soft start, teachers will contact parents to schedule appointments for their child's assessments. More information regarding assessments will be provided by your child's teacher.

Our Young 5's and Kindergarten students **WILL** go to lunch during our soft start days with the exception of the first day, August 29th. We offer free lunch to all students but if you would like to send a packed lunch, please do so. Please note that after September 9th, any half day will NOT include lunchtime.

During soft start only, Young 5's and Kindergarten students that ride the bus will have bus transportation from home to school but there will be NO bus for the school-home portion at 12:05PM. Parents will need to secure transportation for the return.

#### **Attendance:**

It is important to call the school every time your child is going to be absent, tardy, or needs an early dismissal from class so that unnecessary calls to you may be avoided. If your child arrives after 9:00AM you must come into the office to sign your child in. The school office phone number is 313-827-6300. You can leave a message 24 hours on the Attendance line (313) 827-6301. Please speak clearly, say name of child, date and reason for absence and teacher. Or you may report your child's attendance through Parent Connect.

For safety reasons, please remember not to use the staff parking lot as a drop off at any time.

#### **Outdoor Line Up:**

In the morning students will line up at their assigned number. The teachers will be coming outside to pick up and drop off the students every day starting on the first day of school. **We kindly remind parents that they must remain outside the building as students are escorted inside by their teachers.** This will allow for a smooth transition from the start of the school year.

### **Breakfast:**

Free Breakfast will be served daily from **8:35AM-8:50AM.** If interested, they may enter the building from the staff parking lot door (door 2).

#### Lunch:

The district offers free lunch to all students. Classes are given approximately 40 minutes for lunch and recess. Students are given approximately 20 minutes for lunch and approximately 20 minutes for recess. Some classes go to recess first then eat and some eat first then go out for recess.
